Special Training Announcement 2016 NORTH Region Basic Fire Investigation Course

This is a basic fire investigation course designed to provide the student with the knowledge through lecture and hands-on exercises to understand the fire investigation processes. The course will cover the relevant investigative disciplines by incorporating nationally recognized standards, reference materials, and guidelines in the course curriculum.

All classroom lectures will be hosted by the Passaic County Community College Public Safety Academy, 300 Oldham Road, Wayne, New Jersey 07470. Classes will commence on Monday, March 21, 2016 and run consecutive Monday and Wednesday evenings from 1900 to 2200 hours until approximately May 18, 2016. There will be two Saturday practical exercises held, one on April 16, 2016 and the other on May 14, 2016 and will run from 8am to 4pm. A class schedule will be provided the first night of class.

The fee for the course is \$475.00 for current NJ and IAAI members \$525.00 for Non-members (Note: the fee includes a one-year membership in the New Jersey Chapter). Fees include all course materials, student textbooks and lunch on the two practical day sessions.

Class size is limited to 24 students and the registration form must be received by March 14, 2016
