Special Training Announcement
***2018 CENTRAL* Region Basic Fire Investigation Course**

This is a basic fire investigation course designed to provide the student with knowledge through lecture and hands-on exercises to understand the fire investigation processes. The course will cover the relevant investigative disciplines by incorporating nationally recognized standards, reference materials, and guidelines in the course curriculum.

All classroom lectures will be hosted at the Middlesex County Fire Academy, 1001 Fire Academy Drive, Sayreville, NJ 08872. Classes will commence on Monday, September 24, 2018 and run Monday and Wednesday evenings (except for holiday schedule changes) from 1900 to 2300 hours until approximately December 5, 2018. There will be two Saturday practical exercises held on November 10, 2018 and December 1, 2018 which will run from 8am to 4pm. A class schedule will be provided the first night of class.

The fee for the course is \$525.00 for current NJ and IAAI members, \$600.00 for Non-members (Note: the fee includes a one-year membership in the New Jersey Chapter). Fees include all course materials, student textbooks and lunch on both practical day session.

Class size is limited to 30 students and the registration form must be received by September 11, 2018
